

Birdwatching Visit to Llanfairfechan and Glaslyn Wildlife – Ospreys

10th & 11th June 2026

There were 5 of us braving the weather for this visit. Llanfairfechan started with a visit to the Café for a drink and bacon butty. It turned out to be a lot better for weather than expected. We saw quite a bit of sunshine.

We saw 21 different birds on the sea shore and the river valley including Dippers, Grey Wagtails, lots of Little Egrets and a “murmuration” of Oystercatchers.



The next day at [Glaslyn](#) was pouring with rain! From the hide we could easily see three sets of Osprey on their nest by eye, telescope and on a huge television. We saw a female sheltering the three 13-day old chicks, a male bringing in a half-eaten fish, and the female feeding the fish to the chicks. Heather gave us a really interesting talk about the centre and their Ospreys. The centre is certainly worth a visit if you are in the area.
